Prevention is always better than cure and poultry is not an exception. By regularly monitoring your flock, you can prevent diseases that could have not only health and welfare implications but also lead to economic losses. It is recommended that all the flocks are examined by a veterinary surgeon at least once a year. These checks can be more regular if there are any specific problems in the site. The examination of the birds by a veterinarian is important to know the health status of the birds and also to put in place a plan to optimize health, welfare and performance of the birds. Each plan is tailored to the needs of each farm, taking into consideration the species, age of the birds, kind of production, etc.

The health plan is updated every year following a veterinary visit. This update is necessary, as the prevalence of diseases in your area may have changed since last assessment.
